


The **Emerald Ash Borer Beetle (EAB)** kills ash trees. It likes to hide under the bark of firewood.






This tiny pest can destroy ash trees ... but YOU can help stop the Emerald Ash Borer Beetle (EAB). Tell your family:

A Bug's Life (Cycle)

Can you follow the Emerald Ash Borer Beetle (EAB)'s life cycle?

The female EAB lays an egg . When the egg hatches, a larva emerges. The larva burrows into the tree, where it begins to feed and develop under the bark. As it feeds, it makes S-shaped tunnels that damage the tree. Eventually the larva turns into a pupa and then an adult EAB . The adult EAB chews through the bark and escapes , leaving behind a D-shaped exit hole .



YOU can help stop the EAB. Tell your family:

Don't move firewood ... and burn it where you buy it.


Undercover Beetles...

The EAB is hard to spot in nature ... but don't be fooled! They may be hidden, but they can kill trees if we don't stop them.


